

Interview Stories

Explore entertaining stories and inspiring interest in job interviews.

1. Create a theatre event that explores telling better stories in job interviews.
2. Invite some people including:
 - An audience.
 - Three screenwriters.
 - Two actors.
3. Ask four of the audience to attend with an answer to the 'open' question:
 - How do you deal with failure?
4. Ask four of the audience to attend with an answer to the 'closed' question:
 - Do you work beyond the call of duty?
5. Design and prepare an on-stage office environment.
6. Sit the two actors in the office.
7. Sit the panel of three screenwriters in front of the office.
8. Sit the audience behind the panel of screenwriters.
9. The actors host the event in which:
 - a. The actors outline the details of the event to the audience.
 - b. The actors ask the audience the 'open' interview question.
 - c. One audience member stands and answers the 'open' interview question.
 - d. The actors perform the answer to the question on-stage.
 - e. The screenwriters re-write the answer in an entertaining way.
 - f. The actors perform this new more entertaining answer
 - g. The question is re-written and performed four times in total.
 - h. This repeats until all the questions and answers have been addressed.
 - i. Conclude with a discussion about storytelling in job interviews.

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
